Running Paws Camp Information Sheet

Running paws Agility Camp aims to improve many aspects of your agility skills. During the camp we will be focusing on a number of aspects including core handling skills and handling options, course walking, obstacle skills, obstacle discrimination, weave skills, drive and motivation.

There will be three training sessions per day enabling you time with all three trainers. Each session will have a particular focus. A small group size will allow you to have plenty of individual tuition, ability to watch and learn from others in a supportive environment and rest between runs in sessions so that dogs are fresh and able to give their all, and therefore able to make maximum progress throughout the sessions. Additionally there will be seminars where we can focus on more theoretical discussion of agility topics in a relaxed group, possibly using the village hall, while the dogs rest.

About the trainers:

Ceri Jones has been competed in Obedience, Agility and Flyball over the last 32 yrs. She has competed primarily in Obedience up to B level and competed many times at Crufts as a junior in Obedience and Flyball, where she won the Test of Obedience and Top Junior of the year. Ceri has also competed at Crufts in the Agility, firstly with Brynn as a Junior and more recently with Taezr in the Novice cup in 2015 where an unfortunate 5F cost them the win! Ceri has trained Tekcyn (WS), Celyr (Sheltie) and Taezr (and David's papillon Caeyn) to Grade 7. Ceri and Taz have represented the UK at IMCA 2017 in Austria (also qualified to represent UK in 2018), GB at the IFCS 2017 in Spain and IFCS 2018 in Italy.

Dave Russell has been competing for 9 years having made both his dogs up to Grade 7 and has competed at a number of international competitions, including EO 2012 in Sweden, IFCS and WAO, medalling at IFCS and WAO and being crowned 2012 WAO Pentathlon World Champion with his first Papillion Caeyn. He has also won a number of Reserve CC's and one CC with Caeyn. In 2016 when Kyto was just 3 yrs old David represented GB at the IFCS in Holland where they were the highest placed British dog in the Overall competition finishing a credible 8th. David now has his young dog Vudu in training.

Mary Shaw has been involved in agility since she was a small child. As a junior she competed at Crufts a number of times and achieved some fantastic wins in the various junior finals. More recently she has competed in Grade 7 and champ classes. Mary and Reef were part of the GB team competing at the IFCS Championships in Gerona 2013 and also competed in the Novice competition at Olympia

Mary's Zest has so far achieved Grade 6 status and has represented GB at the IFCS Championships 2018 in Milan, Italy. Zest also qualified for the Novice competition at Olympia 2017.

About the venue:

Longden is located approximately 5 miles south of Shrewsbury. The camp venue is close to the centre of the village which has a small local deli shop, post office and pub. The field is large and flat and will provide space for camping and training. The village hall itself has water, cooking, refrigeration, toilet and elsan facilities. We will use the village hall itself for our evening seminars if required. The hall can also be used as a gathering point to enjoy meals together and socialise if desired.

Longden is located on the Shropshire Way, there are numerous walks in the area and within a short distance of the village. Slightly further afield you can explore the Shropshire hills of the Longmynd and Stiperstones.

Camping is available from Monday 27th May until Friday 31st May. However for anyone wishing to come straight from a show, or arrive to enable travel to a show on Bank Holiday Monday, camping may be available from Sunday by prior arrangement. Packington Show, which usually takes place on the Bank Holiday Monday and hosts Novice and ABC Olympia Qualifiers, is just over 1 hr away so if you wish to arrive Sunday, pitch up and leave to go to a show on the Monday, this can be arranged.
